Attendance Policy

We look forward to seeing your child everyday! Every day a child misses school, they miss around 6 hours of instruction. If it is necessary for a student to be absent from school, we require the following:

- **Call The Office:** A parent/guardian needs to call the office on the day or days of the absence. You can leave a message anytime at 989-831-2500.
- or
- **Send a Note To Office:** A parent/guardian may send a written note to the office. This note should give a reason for the absence and the date of the absence.

Central Montcalm does make allowances for students to miss school due to sickness or doctor's appointments. Please obtain a doctor's excuse slip when you're at appointments and send back in their homework folder. In the event that your child is on track to miss a significant amount of days this school year you will receive a letter. At 8 unexcused days, the district may choose to schedule a meeting with a Truancy Officer. Thank you for your help in getting students to school EVERY DAY.
