## Superintendent's Report:

1. Superintendent James submitted a PQ application after meeting with the Michigan Department of Treasury on Friday. He is asking for board approval tonight. Discussion: Has proposal changed? Superintendent replied there have been changes to scope of project and needed funding amount.

## **New Business:**

Motion by Lund, supported by Lingeman, to approve the application for Preliminary Qualification of Bonds. **Be it resolved that,** at the April 8, 2024 Special Meeting, the Central Montcalm Board of Education took the following actions:

- 1. Resolved to apply for preliminary qualification of bonds by the State Treasurer for the purpose of financing the school construction description in the application.
- 2. That said application is presented to the State Treasurer for action prior to the official action of the Board of Education calling the election on said bond issue.
- 3. Resolved that this Board of Education will present a final qualification application to the State Treasurer for qualification of their bonds after this bond issue has been approved by the electors of said district.
- 4. Read the application and approved all statements and representations contained therein as true to the best knowledge and belief of the Board.
- 5. Authorized the Secretary of the Board of Education to sign the Preliminary Application paperwork and submit the same to the State Treasurer for review and approval.

Motion by Collins, supported by Bowen, to adopt the Educational Assistance Program. Those in favor 6, opposed 0. Motion carried.
