In order to be granted articulated credit the student must meet the following requirements:

- 1. The student must earn a "B" or better (3.0 on a 4.0 GPA scale) in each course in order for credit to be articulated
- 2. The student must also begin attending Davenport University within 27 months from the date of their high school graduation.
- The instructor must sign the articulation submission form which verifies the student has met the necessary course work to be granted the articulated credit requested.

Credits articulated will become part of the total number of credits for program completion at Davenport University and will appear on the student's Davenport University transcript by course code and credit hours. No grade will be recorded. Tuition and fees will not be charged for articulated credits.

*Please Note: Davenport University encourages students to take the official Advanced Placement test as credit earned from these test results are more universally accepted than articulated credit. For students who have taken the official Advanced Placement test and scored a "3" or better, please request your Advanced Placement transcript be sent to Davenport University in order for credit to be awarded.
